- **Individual Instruction: 4 units can be comprised of lessons in any performance medium, music technology (MTEC), or conducting (MUCD). Individual instruction can be taken for 1 or 2 units a semester. Conducting classes at the 400-500 level (2 units) can also apply to this requirement.
- ***MUCO 592 may be substituted with another approved MUCO 400-500 level elective.

Electives: Your degree program requires 8 elective units. 4 units of electives must be within the Thornton School. The other 4 can be from any other school or department at USC but must be at the 400-500 level. Consult your advisor if you plan to take non-Thornton electives as they may have pre-requisites or particular D-clearance requirements. MGEE review courses <u>do not</u> count as general elective units.
